
Important Information


- Installation must be carried out by a licensed tradesperson (plumber/builder)
- Special care should be taken when drilling walls to avoid hidden pipes or electrical cables
- Safety gear like a mask, earmuffs and glasses must be worn when using tools
- It is required that these accessories are mounted to a secure and strong surface, and that the installer use appropriate fixing materials for your wall and installation. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Caroma will not accept responsibility for personal injury or damage caused by incorrect installation or poor wall strength, or installation or part installation by any person other than a licensed tradesperson (plumber/builder)
- Clean the surface of the pad with disinfectant cleaner after use
- Never use harsh chemicals that can damage the pad


POINTS TO CONSIDER


Cavity walls-Please ensure the backrest fixing points are secured to the wall's solid framing structure (i.e. studwork/wall supports) to ensure adequate mounting strength of the frame.


Solid walls- For solid wall installation (i.e. brick or concrete), appropriate drilling equipment must be used.










Timber wall

structural wall installation




- Centralise the backrest pad & frame assembly and position on the wall within the recommended height range shown in Fig. 6 (for dual flap seat) and Fig. 7 (for single flap seat).
- Check the level of frame assembly with a spirit level as shown in Fig. 6 and ensure its levelled, then mark the fixing holes on the finished wall.
- Remove the backrest pad assembly from the wall.
- Ensure the correct fasteners for the mounting and drill hole sizes

are selected for timber or masonry installation as specified in Fig 5. Drill the holes at marked locations and fit the backrest assembly on the wall.

- Slide the cover plates carefully back towards the wall and push against the seal until secure.

<u>Important:</u>

For timber stud and non-structural walls, noggins or other suitable means of support must be used to support the backrest at the recommended height.
